

National and International ISDN Costs

National UK ISDN costs

The charge for national UK ISDN videoconferences is 2 pence per channel, per minute, excluding VAT.

Thus an ISDN-6 call, which runs with 6 channels, will be charged according to the following formula: $(6 \times 2p \times \text{duration in minutes}) + \text{VAT}$.

An ISDN-2 call, which runs with 2 channels, will be charged according to the following formula: $(2 \times 2p \times \text{duration in minutes}) + \text{VAT}$.

International ISDN costs

The list of countries below is not complete, but includes all the countries that have been dialled by JVCS and a significant number of additional numbers.

The costs were obtained from one of the telcos that provides JVCS with ISDN lines. These costs have been cross-checked with invoices for ISDN videoconferencing as received by UKERNA in the last 12 months, and reflect the actual cost of the calls that have been made.
